The Corporate Sales and Fleet Management Executive for Altech Netstar in Limpopo Mr Sakkie Meyer said the system will have good benefits to the College. There will be cost reduction to maintain College vehicles as it will bring more accountability and responsibility amongst drivers. Drivers must look at their behaviours must be responsible and follow road rules. The system will report any driving misconduct to the fleet management officials. Mr Meyer added that there is a buzzer which warns if a driver is driving recklessly, it can buzz due to harsh idling, breaking or cornering, rude violation and taking unauthorised trip or route. There is also a panic button installed in all vehicles in case of car hijacking. The system is now 20 years old
